The Crosshatch Settee is available in a selection of natural woods in more than 30 finishes, a wide variety of upholstery options, and varying cord colors to help it blend in or stand out across a range of interiors.

With list pricing starting at \$3,915, the Crosshatch Settee will be orderable through Geiger and Herman Miller's North American contract dealer network—beginning summer 2019.
