Alongside the Saarinen Tables, some of the modern classics designed by architects like Florence Knoll, Mies van der Rohe, Eero Saarinen, Harry Bertoia and Marcel Bruer are on view together with Knoll latest new introductions, such as Lissoni's Outdoor Collection that reflects Piero Lissoni's elegant style and is inspired to Knoll's historic 1966 Collection by Richard Schultz.

Lissoni's Outdoor Collection is distinguished by its essential lines and comes with an aluminium frame, available in white, onyx and dark red. The micro-perforated pattern on the back of the sofa and armchair's backrest catches the eye and defines its contemporary aesthetic, while the large cushions and upholstery of the seats ensure an absolute level of comfort and informal relaxation. The covers of the seat and back cushions are fully removable and suitable for extended outdoor use. To accompany the new outdoor offerings, Knoll is introducing a selection of outdoor fabrics that allow numerous customization options, ensuring maximum performance and original color combinations.
